Hindi:-

1. Write a page of Hindi Sulekh Sarita daily.
2. Visit a nearby park. Observe the surroundings and based on your observation draw and describe what you saw in the park.
3. Write five sentences describing the places you visited during summer vacations.

Mathematics:-

1. Make a clown/ rangloi pattern using four basic shapes (Square, Triangle, Rectangle and Circle)

OR

Represent combinations of 10 on a cardboard using chart paper, matchsticks/tooth picks/ kidney beans.
