A. Write a paragraph on any well known historical tourist destination of your state. Paste pictures.

B. On an A3 sheet, make the outline of the state showing the following:-

- (i) it's capital
- (ii) a main river
- (iii) a major crop
- (iv) one distinguishing feature of the state (development/ infrastructure/ tourism etc)
- (v) dance/art form
- (vi) Paste pictures & write the names of the CM and Governor of the state.

C.

- (a) Name and paste pictures of the 'state- bird' and 'state animal'. Also, mention their habitats.
- (b) Describe how they have adapted themselves to the environment of the state.

D. Name any 5 prominent states of India, Mention their area and arrange the states in ascending order of their land area.

- (a) Write the area in words. (Both in Indian and International system)
- (b) Round the figures (the area) to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.
